OUR GOALS:

Our physical space and infrastructure

The Library has the space and tools it needs to serve people with diverse interests and abilities.

- Continue to address the need for more space and better accessibility
- Update and continue to develop the use of technology in and around the library..
- Find ways to use the space we have now for compelling programs and experiences.
- Create space (and programs) that support calm and offer a respite from hectic life.
- Focus on environmental sustainability in how the library operates.

Sample activities:

- Develop more awareness materials about positive impact of expanded library
- Faster Wifi
- Host more outdoor and after hour programs.
- Create anti-stress zones with prompts for meditation and mindfulness
- Model and explore energy efficiency

- Partner with our community to build engagement with and awareness of the Library.

- Provide opportunities for and education about civic dialogue and engagement.
- Support our community in understanding and dealing with rapid social change
- Partner with other groups in Deerfield and the region to share resources and further our combined interests.
- Partner with other local public and academic libraries libraries to co-create programs and share resources.

Sample activities:

- Deliver library materials to people unable to visit library
- Create programs for multi- generational, cultural, and gender patrons.
- Promote awareness on election process.
- Partner with town committees
- Develop teen programs with other libraries.

Activities and resources for our community

Our collection, services, and programs align with the needs and interests of our community.

- Develop creative ways to present our resources to increase awareness and usage
- Create more drop-in activities for all ages, to bring people in at times that work for their schedules.
- Diversify our collection.
- Create opportunities for learning about and use of technology at the Library.
- Expand and diversify programs for teens and adults.
- Expand and diversify programs for kids.
- Build awareness of resources available through the library.

Sample activities:

- Create drop-in crafts and maker projects with on-site supplies and instructions
- Expand "Library of Things" offerings: tools, craft kits, music equipment, for example.
- Offer "Tech Tuesdays."
- Regularly hold programs on topics like Minecraft, nutrition, history, writing, art, etc...
- Provide more programs involving animals for help for reading and wellness.
